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### NEW STUDENT REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

Thank you for your interest in St. Elizabeth of Hungary Catholic School. Registration at St. Elizabeth is a process. Many factors are considered for acceptance and enrollment into St. Elizabeth School. Please bring this form and the following required information on your scheduled testing day.

**Note:** Applications for Admission will not be accepted until the application is complete with the following items:

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#### Application Process:

- Completed Registration Form
- Testing fee of \$50 grades 2nd - 8th
- School Records - Transcript including all educational and diagnostic testing and report cards from previous schools (entering grades 1-8)
- Most recent Standardized Test Scores, (i.e. Benchmark, ITBS, TAKS)
- Date of Birth \_\_\_\_\_

- Parent Questionnaire
- Confidential Teacher Evaluation form (from current teachers) mailed or faxed directly to St. Elizabeth School.
- Confidential Family Recommendation Letter sent by your current school administrator. Letter should include parents' involvement and cooperation in the school and parish (if applicable) and student's academic potential and progress as well as deportment. The letter must be mailed from your current school on their letterhead to the attention of Admissions. (Not delivered by the parent but mailed by the school.)
- Birth Certificate (copy from the Bureau of Vital Statistics)
- Baptismal Certificate (copy) - Catholics only
- Immunization Records - Records must include month, day and year of each shot, and the health care provider's signature or stamp. Students who are not in compliance with state immunization guidelines will not be allowed to attend school.
- Copy of Custody Decree (if applicable)
- Registration Fees
- After the placement test is administered, it will be reviewed by the Principal and a team of teachers for recommendations (for example: acceptance & placement, re-testing, tutoring, summer school, etc.).
- A student & parent interview with the principal will be required for all students being considered for grades 4-8.

**Please Note:** Children entering Pre-K must be 4 years old on or before September 1st and children entering Kindergarten must be 5 years old on or before September 1st.
